

DID YOU KNOW?

- UFS got a grade 4 in the General Index of Courses (IGC) and this places us among the best universities in the Northeast. In addition, in the last evaluation cycle of the Ministry of Education (MEC), 94.6% of our courses were evaluated as very good (grade 4) or excellent (grade 5).
- The purpose of the Support Program for the Development of Professional Learning (Prodap) is to provide undergraduate students with grants so that they can take part in 20-hour-weekly activities focusing on the development of skills aimed at complementing professional training in the scope of the UFS. - The Faculty Qualification Index (ICQD) is an indicator to measure the qualification of the tenured professors, calculated by the weighted average with the following weights: undergraduate degree = 1, specialization = 2, master's = 3, doctorate = 5. - The Monitoring Program offers undergraduate students the opportunity to experience didactic-pedagogical experiences with the support of a supervisor professor, who will help them develop skills related to teaching practice. - Extension activities are characterized as extension programs, projects, courses and events and are registered on SIGAA by faculty members and/or technical staff, based on specific public notices. - The Success Ratio is an annual indicator that shows the percentage of graduates, each year, concerning the total of retroactive entrants considering the minimum completion time of each course. For example, consider a course with a minimum completion time of 8 terms. In 2020 there were XX graduates and the number of retroactive entrants (2016/2 and 2016/1) was YY.
